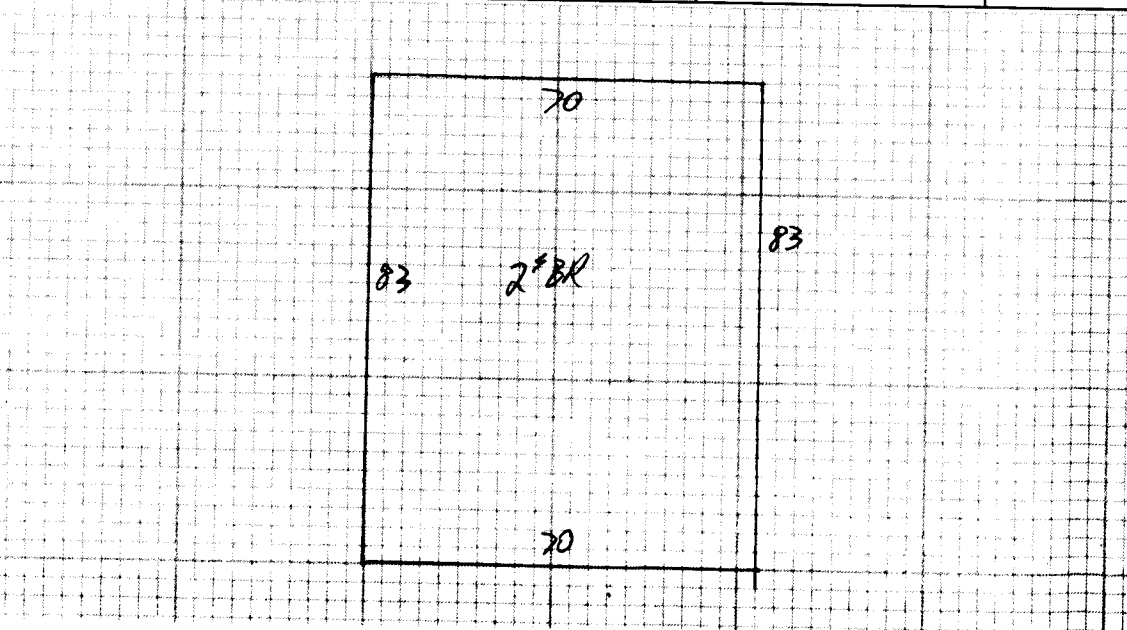

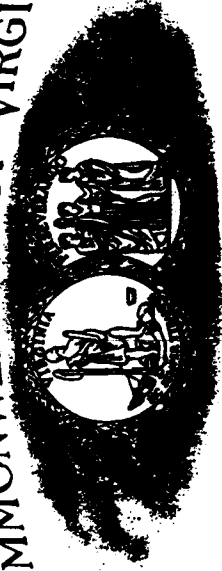

Your request of July 23, 1974 in relation to the above corporation has been received.

Section 58-128 of the Code of Virginia exempts from the corporation income tax, corporations not organized or conducted for pecuniary profit.

The above named corporation is a non-profit, non-dividend paying corporation. For so long a time as it is operated in accordance with its existing charter, the corporation will be held not liable to the Virginia State Income Tax, on the ground that it is not organized or conducted for pecuniary profit.

Dear Mr. Artrip:

Reference is made to your letter of September 29, 1970 concerning the status of The Cumberland Museum with respect to local property taxation.

The Cumberland Museum was chartered by the State Corporation Commission earlier this year as a non-stock, non-profit corporation.

Section 58-12 (7) of the Code of Virginia exempts from taxation, among other property, the property of "any corporation organized to establish and maintain a museum or museums, with or without a library or libraries, provided such corporation be not operated for any profit...."

It is my view that the property of The Cumberland Museum is exempt from taxation as long as it is operated for the purposes set out in its Articles of Incorporation provided such corporation be not operated for any profit.
