CATHERINE STOOKEY

This deed made and entered into this March, 5th, 1956 between G. Mark French and Bessie French his wife parties of the first part and Catherine Stookey party of the second part.

WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of love and affection the said parties of the first part do grant, sell and convey with covenants of general warranty of title unto the said party of the second part his undivided 1/3 interest in and to all the surface of the tract of land conveyed to him and Meriteth G. Duty and Levi J. Duty for deed bearing date on the 31st day of October, 1927 and of record in the clerks office of Dickenson in Deed Book No. 57 at page 400. reference to said deed where recorded is hereby made for a more particular description of the land hereby conveyed.

The said grantee G. Mark French reserved from said conveyance the coal and mineral and full and complete mining rights to gather with the right to strip and to break the overlying surface of said land and the right of way to the public road as conveyed in the said deed dated and mentioned as aforesaid.
